INTRODUCTION

The book of Acts details many of the early disciples of Jesus and some of the trail blazers of the emerging church. One of those people is a woman by the name of Priscilla. In Acts 18 we are given a snap shot of this amazing disciple of Jesus but enough to learn some valuable lessons being a follower of Jesus.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read Acts 18:1-3. Have you ever developed a friendship as a result of meeting someone through a shared skill or specific interest? Share an example or a time this happened for you.
2. Read Acts 18:2. Priscilla and her husband had been deported and forced to leave their homeland. Read Psalm 37:23-24 and Psalm 32:8. Discuss the concept of making the most of every relocation experience you have.
3. Read Acts 18:24-26. Priscilla and her husband were helpful to a young enthusiastic teacher named Apollos. Specifically what did they do according to verse 26 that was helpful to Apollos?
4. Read Romans 16:3-5. In what ways does Paul validate Priscilla and her husband as co-workers in the ministry of the gospel?
5. Read Acts 21:7-9. The final sentence in this scripture talks about the four daughters of Philip who had special ability from the Holy Spirit. What ability did God give them? 1 Corinthians 14:31 provides a description of this gift when used effectively.
