DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

 - d. If so, why are you on a mission to obtain that resolution or goal?

- 2) The Holy Spirit and Bible are two gifts that God has given us in order to connect with Him and understand what's most important. Discuss with your group topics or concepts that the Holy Spirit or Bible has taught you to be of importance.

- 3) Read Proverbs 4:7 and discuss what this means to you.
 - a. Have you ever asked God for wisdom? How did you realize you were in need of it?
 - b. Who is the wisest person you know? What qualities do they possess?

- 4) Read Proverbs 9:10-11 and discuss what the fear of the Lord is. Also, why do you think wisdom adds years to our lives?

- 5) Meditate on this quote – "Wisdom has more to do with relationship than information." (Reference 1 Corinthians 1:30). Are you finding more wisdom as you draw closer to Jesus? If you answered yes, explain to your group how so.
